



## COVID 19 Action Plan & Policy

When entering the CRRVP property, you do so at your own risk and peril.

We will have signs at the gate and the community bulletin board advising you of any notices or information regarding the park. Also please refer to the community Facebook page and our website.

The key code pad will not accept a code and will only open with your gate card. Please don't forget to bring your gate card with you, and for those of you who have not yet received your cards, we'll make prior arrangements. We are restricting access to all individuals including friends, relatives, service technicians and delivery personnel. This means no unauthorized person should enter our gated community. In case this needs clarification, you are not allowed to have anyone on site that isn't listed as a dependent on your tenant information package.

If you are having something delivered (ie takeout food) you must meet them at the gate, as they are not allowed to enter. If you require a service technician, you must first advise a CRRVP representative who will log the request and track the entrance and exit time. We require a minimum of 24 hours advance notice for any request.

When entering the park please ensure that no one enters behind you and that the gate closes before you drive away. When exiting the park, please ensure that the gate closes before you drive away. If there is someone behind you that is exiting at the same time, we would expect the last person to remain at the gate until it is closed.

(Social distancing) a minimum of (two meters) is in effect, and must be practiced by everyone. Please ensure you maintain the proper social distance. You are responsible for the safety of your children, please monitor your children to ensure that they are practicing social distancing.

Please do not approach your neighbors camp site at any time, because as innocent as this may seem to you, many people will consider this an inappropriate intrusion of their space. Please do not cut through anyone's site. Social distancing rules must be strictly adhered to for all campfires.

If we receive complaints that someone fails to maintain social distancing, that person or persons will be verbally asked by CRRVP to conduct themselves in a responsible manner.

Verbally with the first infraction, second infraction an incident report will be completed, and the third infraction will result in expulsion and all funds paid will be forfeited.

When approaching a CRRVP employee, the same social distancing rules apply. Please respect the fact that we want everyone including management and employees to remain healthy.

Group assembly is not allowed as per all government regulations.

We plan to set up sanitizing/disinfecting stations at the washhouse and the garbage bin areas. This will consist of a one-gallon pump type bottle; hand washing is still the best way to reduce the possibility of infection which can be carried out at your RV. Please wash your hands often. Please advise a CRRVP representative if the hand sanitizer is getting low.

As per Alberta Health regulations all common areas are to remain closed until further notice. At our park this means the washhouse, playground, basketball court, volleyball court, horseshoe pit and finally the common area at the east end are all closed. Please ensure children understand these areas are closed and out of bounds for any activity.

We will fence off the playground area as best as we can, however, we ask that everyone be vigilant to ensure children do not congregate or try to play there.

CRRVP will not allow any guests of tenants for weekend or overnight stays as per AHS regulations.

CRRVP has a minimum requirement of a five-week lease. This may change depending on AHS regulations.

We are not leasing any unserviced sites this year.

Please ensure that you have purchased the bulk of your supplies from your hometown(city) providers in advance. This, of course, reduces the strain on local suppliers, as we are a small town and only have one grocery store.

In order to reduce stress on our local health care providers, we ask that you stay home or go home if you display any symptoms, sore throat, fever, dry cough or shortness of breath. If you are leaving because you are experiencing any of the symptoms, please make us aware of this information.

The Federal Quarantine Act is in effect, and therefore you must stay home if you display any symptoms of COVID 19 or if you have been out of the country in the last 14 days. You cannot self-isolate or quarantine here at CRRVP.

Please understand that all policies listed are for your welfare. If any new regulations need to be implemented we will communicate this via our community Facebook page or our website. This plan can be modified as we find necessary.

If government infractions triggered by a tenant's actions force CRRVP to close, then everyone will be penalized. AHS representatives will be conducting random checks on our facility. This could happen at any time of day or night without warning. If they find tenants failing to follow the policies outlined, they may the tenant to leave or they could force us to close the park.
