



## COVID-19 Action Plan & Policy

Effective June 10, 2021

The below will outline our plan to help maintain the health and safety of our RV Park Members and Staff. We ask that you thoroughly read the terms set out below. Your signature at the bottom will signify that you have read through the policy and agree to the terms.

### General COVID-19 Policies

- When entering the Crowsnest River RV Park (CRRVP) property, you do so at your own risk and peril.
- You are expected to stay up to date with all provincial and local restrictions and regulations. We will be following provincial regulations at CRRVP.
- If you, or any member of your household, displays symptoms (cough, fever, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, or any of the other symptoms listed at [Alberta.ca/covid](https://www.alberta.ca/covid)) you are asked to stay, or go, back to your home to isolate and arrange for testing. You are not permitted to self-isolate at CRRVP.
- If you experience symptoms while at the RV Park, please notify a CRRVP representative for contact tracing records. All records will be kept confidential.
- We will have signs at the gate and the community bulletin board advising you of any notices or information regarding the park. Also please refer to the community Facebook page and our website.
- The key code pad will not accept a code and will only open with your gate card. Please don't forget to bring your gate card with you.
- Proper sanitizing, mask use, and social distancing (2 metres) must be practiced by everyone. You are responsible for the safety of your children, please monitor your children to ensure that they are practicing this as well.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be set up at the washhouse, garbage bin, and playground areas. Sanitize frequently but hand washing, carried out in your RV, is still the best way to reduce the spread of infection. Please wash your hands often. Advise a CRRVP representative if hand sanitizer stations are getting low.
- Do not enter another campsite without prior permission from the site owner. Please do not cut through occupied sites. Social distancing, and group maximum rules must be strictly adhered to for all campfires.

- Social distance and mask rules apply when approaching a CRRVP employees. Please respect the fact that we want everyone, including management and employees, to remain healthy.

### Visitors/Guests/Service Technicians

- Daytime visitors are permitted at the RV Park. Visitors must adhere to all RV Park policies, including Covid-19 Policies. As stated in our regular policies, the **number of daytime visitors per site is limited to six (6)** and may only be present at the park while you, the member, is present.
- Visitors must be met at the gate, by a CRRV member, and are to park in the visitor parking lot. ANY person exhibiting symptoms will not be permitted in the park.
- As advised by AHS, indoor social gatherings are still not permitted. At this time, visitors from outside your household are not permitted to stay overnight. We will be reviewing the provincial regulations, and this policy, on a biweekly basis and will update all members of any changes.
- No unauthorized person should enter our gated community. Delivery personnel (ie. Take out food, etc.) must be met at the gate by you.
- Service technicians are permitted. Before they arrive, please advise a CRRVP representative who will log the request. Please inform the technician to sign in and out with the camp host. We require a minimum of 24 hours advance notice for any request.
- When entering or exiting the park, please wait to ensure the gate closes behind you and that no one has entered behind you. If someone is exiting behind you, we would expect the last person to remain at the gate until it is closed. (We are intending to provide rearview mirror hangers so that other members are easily identifiable. Until that time, please follow the rule of waiting for the gate and please be patient with others who are following this rule.)

### Facilities

- Effective June 11, the Washhouse will be open. Please limit the number of people inside at one time to **one household** at a time. Sanitizing of the washhouse will only be done twice per day; use is at your own discretion. Proper distancing, masking, and hygiene protocols are to be followed while inside the washhouse
- The playground will be open, with the expectation that parents/guardians will monitor their children's sanitizing protocol. Please take turns as households, sanitize often, and consider masks for children over age 2.
- Outdoor sports where 2 metre distancing cannot be maintained are prohibited. The basketball court and volleyball net may only be used by members of the same household. Please allow other households to have opportunities to take turns.

- The horseshoe pit is open for use as long as 2 metre distancing is maintained and hand sanitizer is used frequently. Please sanitize the horseshoes before returning to storage box.
- The common area in the east side of the family side is open for use, provided there is no gathering of more than 10 people and that social distancing between households is maintained.

Violations of the above policies will result in a verbal reminder, by CRRVP, of the requirement to follow the policies. A second violation will result in a written incident report. Third violation will result in expulsion and all funds paid will be forfeited.

Government infractions due to a tenant not following these policies could result in the closure of the RV Park, which impacts us all. AHS representatives will be conducting random adherence checks and could happen any time of day or night, without warning. If a tenant is found to not be following the policies outlined above, the tenant may receive a fine, be asked to leave the park, or request a closure of the park completely.

We thank you for your co-operation, patience, and understanding with these policies. They are in place to ensure that everyone in the park has a healthy, happy, camping season.
